

HOW TO DELETE OLDER CERTIFICATES FROM COMPUTER MEMORY? SIGN-IN METHOD: CERTIFICATE


Use this manual, if:

- You sign in using an eToken or a cryptographic card to the ING Business system and
- You see more than one certificate available for selection on the list of certificates when signing in, or
- You have just generated a new certificate and you want to delete the older one from the memory of your computer

STEP 1


Expand the Start menu and place the cursor in the application search engine. Enter **certmgr.msc** and click **Enter**.





STEP 2


Select **Personal – Certificates** in the window on the left and compare **Expiry dates** of certificates in the window on the right.





STEP 3

Delete older certificates. Click on the expired certificate with the right mouse button and select **Delete**.



After deleting all expired certificates, you will have only valid certificates to select on the list of certificates when signing in.
