

We are changing the Table of Fees and Commissions.

On April 1, 2026, we are changing the “Table of Fees and Commissions of ING Bank Śląski Spółka Akcyjna for residents and non-residents being legal entities and entities not holding legal capacity. Part II: for Corporates/Wholesale Banking”.

The most important changes:

- we introduce a fee for charging via credit card and charge of an account in Revolut, ZEN, and Wise – 9% of the transaction value,
- we introduce a new option for urgent delivery of a card ordered via online banking to a selected point from the bank’s list (InPost parcel locker). The fee for this service is PLN 17,
- we specify the provision regarding the currency conversion commission – without changing its amount. We indicate that the commission is 3.5% in the rate from the Exchange Rate Table or a maximum of 1.5% of the transaction amount at the transaction rate in the Kantor application,
- we increase the fee for providing information for the purposes of a Client’s auditor based on an inquiry received electronically via the System or through a dedicated form on the bank’s website to PLN 700,
- we change the fee collection method for the ING eTerminal Application – we resign from the one-off fee of PLN 343 net and introduce a monthly subscription fee of PLN 8 net for each application made available,
- we amend the description method of SWIFT services by unifying the naming and presentation of the service, while keeping the existing fees.
