

## We are changing the Fees and Commissions Table

On **1 April 2026**, we are updating the “Fees and Commissions Table for Companies and Local Government Units of ING Bank Śląski S.A. for residents and non-residents that are legal entities and organizational units without legal personality” (hereinafter: **Fees and Commissions Table**).

### Key changes

- We are introducing a new service – delivery of a card to an InPost Parcel Locker – PLN 17.
- We are introducing a fee for topping up accounts at Revolut, ZEN, Wise via credit or charge cards – 9% of the transaction value.
- We are changing the method of charging for the ING eTerminal Application – we are removing the one-time fee of PLN 343 net. We are introducing a monthly subscription fee of PLN 8 net for each provided application.
- We are introducing a new fee for failure to provide on time a financial document confirming the fulfilment of an obligation. The fee is PLN 1,000, charged monthly until the required document is delivered.
- We are modifying the fee for failure to provide on time a non-financial document confirming the fulfilment of an obligation – PLN 500 (monthly fee, charged for each document).
- We are introducing a fee for breaching credit agreement conditions related to the customer’s financial situation (e.g., financial ratio). The fee is PLN 500, charged separately for each instance (or period) in which the breach occurred.
- We are clarifying the provision on the currency conversion fee, without changing its amount. We specify that the commission is 3.5% using the Exchange Rate Table price, or a maximum of 1.5% of the transaction amount at the transactional rate in the Kantor application.

If such a statement is submitted, the relevant provisions of the regulations will apply.
